

CV of Prof HJM (Herman) van Rossum

After graduation as a medical doctor at the University of Groningen in 1972 he took his PhD in medical education in 1977 on a comparative study of three problem oriented educational formats in Obstetrics and Gynaecology. From 1978 until 1990 he developed a training centre for basic medical skills in the Leyden Medical Faculty. In 1987-1988 he developed an instrument for estimating diagnostic judgment during a sabbatical leave at the McMasters University. In 1990-2001 he designed a new medical curriculum for the medical faculty of the Groningen University. From 2001 until now he is the architect of the new medical curriculum at the VUA. He is past president of the Dutch Association of Medical Education and was a member of two executive boards of European associations for medical education. He is a current member of the task force evaluating proposals for competence-based programmes for all medical specialties in the Netherlands. He teaches in the Master in Medical Education program of the University of Bern.
