- Teaching experience at postgraduate level and ability to initiate and supervise research projects.

Duties: The successful applicant will be required to:

- Design, compile and present course material for postgraduate degrees.
- Coordinate clinical pharmacy option in the MSc (Med) Programme.
- Supervise and perform clinical work.
- Initiate, conduct and supervise research.
- Supervise postgraduate students.
- Assist with other programmes in the Department of Pharmacy.
