#### LAW, GENDER AND SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION

**AUGUST/ SEPTEMBER 2010**

**Turfloop:** The School of Law made it its convention to host a **Law Week** programme that form part of the annual agenda of the Lawyers in South Africa and Southern Africa. The theme of the conference for 2010 will be the same as the once that were held in the past: **Law, Gender and Social Transformation**.
